POST: Assistant Grower

LOCATION: Five acre community farm (Wolston Lane, Ryton-on-Dunsmore, Coventry, CV8 3LG) We are neighbours of Garden Organic and Coventry University's Centre for Agroecology, Water and Resilience, in the Avon catchment near Ryton-on-Dunsmore and Wolston.

REPORTS TO: Head Grower & Farm Manager

HOURS/SALARY: 3 days per week (7 hours a day) at the national living wage (£12.60 per hour) from March through October. The contract would include holiday pay and pension contributions. However, we understand that time is tight, so there could be some flexibility for the chosen candidate to accommodate for the notice period to their current employer.

ABOUT THE FARM

Comprising a 6.5Ac veg field with agroforestry and polytunnels, plus an acre of established orchard and about ½ acre of structures (barn, packhouse, shed, glasshouse and picnic area). We have been growing field scale organic veg and fruit for 12 years as an organic CSA on 8 acres. We don't buy anything in, yet provide a share of the harvest all year round for a membership of 90 families, harvesting twice a week.

Overall Purpose: To assist with most aspects of organic vegetable growing and harvesting at the farm, thereby helping ensure the year-round availability of seasonal, high quality, and varied produce for our membership.

Specific Duties:

- 1. Liaise with the head grower and farm manager regarding the weekly workflow.
- 2. Work closely with the head grower and farm manager on almost all tasks involved with growing and harvesting of crops
- 3. Help facilitate volunteer sessions with groups of mixed ages and abilities.
- 4. Observe the standards set by the Soil Association for organic horticulture in caring for the land and keeping it in good heart.
- 5. Follow appropriate health and safety onsite and support others in doing so.
- 6. Uphold the principles and aims of the community farm and be prepared to play a role in the steering group IE. developing management and strategic plans for the organisation.

Other Conditions:

Regular work is required on specific days (including 1 Saturday per month) due to volunteer mornings and collection days. There is scope for flexibility in working times throughout the week, with agreement from the rest of the team.

It is the nature of horticultural work that the work flow is sometimes unpredictable and varied. All staff are therefore expected to work in an adaptable manner, and may have to carry out tasks that are not specifically covered in the Job Description.
